## NOTES:

1. A principal member of GEMS (“**Member**”) who is eligible to attend and vote at the AGM is entitled to appoint a proxy to attend, speak and on a poll vote in his/her stead, **provided that such proxy is also a current and fully paid-up Member of GEMS and signs this Proxy Form together with the Member who appoints him/her.**
2. The Member may insert the name of another Member whom he/she wishes to appoint as his/her proxy in the blank spaces provided for that purpose on the face of this Proxy Form. **It is important to note that if the name of a person who is not a Member of GEMS is inserted, this Proxy Form will be disregarded.**
3. **It is also important to note that the following trustees, who were appointed by the Minister for Public Service and Administration, and the Independent Chairperson of the GEMS Audit Committee, are not Members of GEMS, and therefore, cannot be appointed as proxies:**

4. **The following trustees, who are Members of GEMS, may be appointed as proxies:**

  - h. Mr. Alvin Phumudzo Rapea.
5. Proxy Forms must be signed, dated and returned to GEMS to **Private Bag X782, CAPE TOWN, 8000**, or emailed to **enquiries@gems.gov.za**, or faxed to **0861 00 4367** by not later than **16h00 on Friday, 24 July 2026. Proxy Forms received after this time will not be considered, as prescribed by the GEMS Rules.**
6. Proxy Forms appointing trustees or other officers of GEMS who are Members, will be signed by such officers after GEMS’ receipt of same, but prior to the AGM. Therefore, **in such instances only**, Members may sign and submit their Proxy Forms to GEMS without their proxy’s signature.
7. **Proxy Forms that are not completed correctly will be deemed as spoilt and will be disregarded.**
8. The motions for resolution referred to at Motion Number 1, 2 and 3 in the table above, must be taken to the AGM and voted on by the Members present at the AGM, as prescribed by the GEMS Rules.
9. The completion and lodging of this Proxy Form by a Member will not preclude the Member from attending the AGM, and speaking and voting, virtually to the exclusion of any proxy appointed in terms hereof, should the Member wish to do so.
10. If a Member does not indicate in the appropriate place in the table above how he/she wishes to vote in respect of any motion for resolution, or in the event that a Member’s choice is not clearly displayed, his/her proxy shall be entitled to vote as he/she deems fit in respect of that motion.

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
